



Assemble at the airport and depart for **Cairo**, the capital of Egypt.

DAY 2 CAIRO

past **Tahrir Square** and visit the **Egyptian museum** and see the treasure room for the child king Tutankhamen. Explore the **Saleh El-Din Citadel** and **Mohamed Ali Mosque**. Thereafter, check in to your hotel and rest for the day.

in the world: **Great Pyramid of Giza**, the remarkable **Great Sphinx of Giza**, and the **Valley Temple** facing the great statue. Marvel at these breathtaking achievements of human development that for millennium have existed in this place. Conclude your visit to the pyramids with a **camel ride**.

Continue your journey to the ancient capital of **Memphis**, where the colossal statue of Pharaoh Ramses II and a great alabaster sphinx stand. Thereafter, proceed to **Pyramid of Djoser**, the oldest limestone structure in the world built to honour the Pharaoh Zoser.

DAY 4 CAIRO ▶ ASWAN ▶ NILE CRUISE

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Start your fourth day journeying to Aswan, a city in southern Egypt. There, board the **Nile Cruise**. As the day moves along, drop by the **Temple of Philae** and the gigantic **Unfinished Obelisk**. Next, you may take an optional ride in a felucca, a traditional wooden sail boat, down the Nile. As the night comes to a close, return to the cruise for some rest.

Note: Overnight cruise may not stop at city port stated is subjected to cruise schedule.

DAY 5 NILE CRUISE ASWAN ▶ KOM OMBO ▶ EDFU

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Enter the **Abu Simbel**, which are made of two massive rock temples. Then, take to the **Aswan High Dam**. It was built to reduce floods in the Nile, as well as to protect the ancient granite quarries. Sail over to **Kom Ombo**, an Egyptian town, where you can find

the **Temple of Gods Sobek** and **Haroeris**. Back on the ship, proceed on to **Edfu** and retire into the night on the cruise.

DAY 6 NILE CRUISE EDFU ▶ LUXOR

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Going pass the **Esna locks** on the Nile River, arrive at Edfu and head to the **Temple of Horus**. Built between 237B.C. and 57B.C., it sits above ruins of earlier temples and boasts Egyptian inscriptions and symbols. Carry on with a trip to **Luxor**.

DAY 7 LUXOR ▶ HURGHADA

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Arriving at Luxor, this is where the sea voyage on the Nile Cruise ends. Start the journey to the west bank of the Nile to visit **Valley of the Kings**, where tombs were built for the pharaohs and powerful nobles of the New Kingdom of ancient Egypt. Next, visit **Temple of Hatshepsut**, a mortuary temple dedicated to the Sun God. Pass by **Colossi of Memnon**, 2 massive stone statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III. The next pit stop of the day is at the **Temple of Luxor**, built in the time of Pharaoh Amenhotep II and Pharaoh Ramses II. Follow by the **Karnak Temple Complex**, one of the largest temple complexes in history. Then, end the day by travelling to the Egyptian resort city, Hurghada.

DAY 8 HURGHADA

Breakfast, Dinner

Spend the day at your leisure. You can choose

to either rest and relax in the beach or just explore the region. You may also venture off-track to the desert safari via a 4x4 jeep at own expense.

DAY 9 HURGHADA ▶ CAIRO

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Depart to Cairo, where you will be introduced to the oldest oriental market in the country. Known as **Khan El Khalili Market**, it displays its colourful native gems and other trinkets along the street, which receives many visitors.

DAY 10 CAIRO ▶ HOME

Bid Cairo farewell and head to the airport for your flight back home.
