A town in the heart of Italy dominated by the mountain.

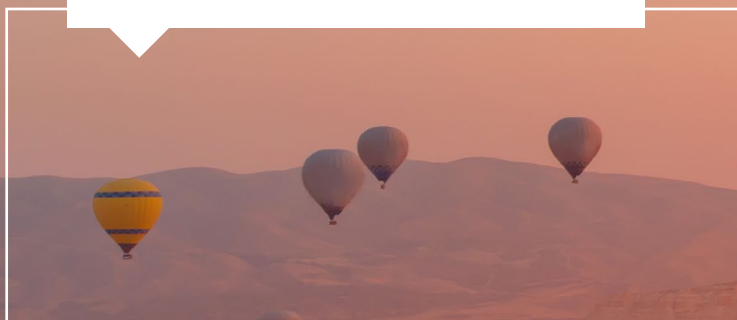
Santorini (Greek Islands)

This ancient volcano is now an island, well-known for its stunning views of the Aegean Sea, white houses with blue roofs, black sand beaches, and its volcanic landscape.



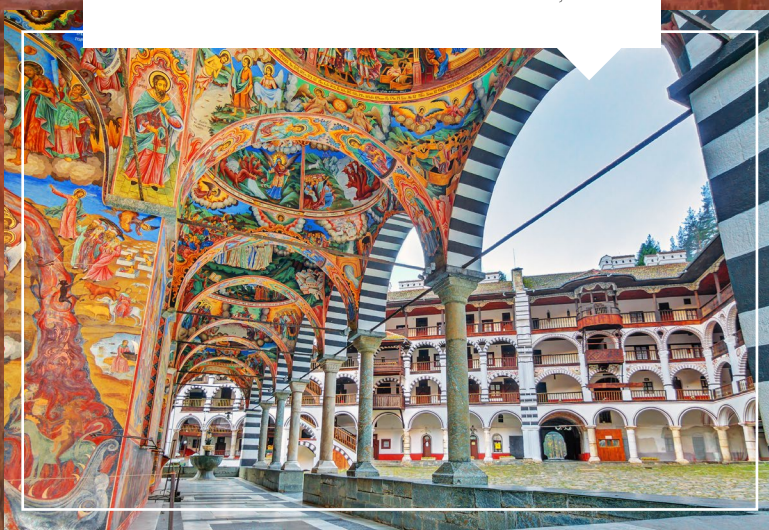
Cappadocia (Turkey)
