The capital of Mexico, it's a dynamic and diverse metropolis that combines rich pre-Hispanic history with modernity.



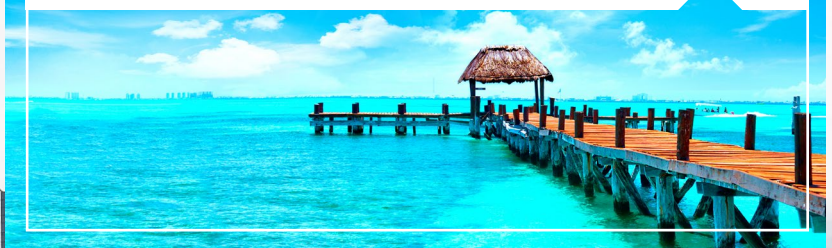
Teotihuacan (Mexico)
